# Jordan Schnitzer CARE SUMMERSTAGE

- Important Information -

The health and safety of our patrons, dancers, and staff is our top priority. To ensure the safety of all and comply with state and local safety guidelines, we have adopted the following procedures and measures for the Jordan Schnitzer CARE Summerstage\* at 1945 SE Water Ave. Portland OR 97214. <u>MAP</u>

### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- Masks will be required at all times except when you are actively eating or drinking.
- The venue will be cleaned and sanitized between each performance.
- There will be signage and OBT representatives to remind patrons of all social distancing and masking rules.
- There will be multiple hand sanitizing stations available at the venue.
- There is no coat or bag check at the venue.

# **GUIDELINES OBT LIVE PERFORMANCE**

- Seating for performances will be in socially distanced pods, ensuring groups are six feet apart.
- The maximum capacity in the venue is 150 people, including staff and dancers.
- There will be no food or drink allowed in the venue during OBT LIVE performances EXCEPT during the June 5 premiere and OBT happening during which food and drink will be provided by licensed and trained catering staff who strictly adhere to guidelines will be allowed in the venue.

## **GUIDELINES PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION**

### For OBT LIVE

- Limited street parking is available
- Patrons will receive a link to prepay for \$5 parking at the OMSI South Lot adjacent to the venue

### For OBT happening

- Valet parking is not current allowed in Oregon; guests will self-park in the OMSI South lot and keep their keys.
- Transportation for dinner quests will be to and from Clarklewis 1001 SE Water Ave, Portland) and the Jordan Schnitzer CARE Summerstage\* in golf carts. The golf carts are open-air and will seat up to six people per trip, depending on bubbles. The driver will be separated from the guest by a Plexi-shield and will sanitize the cart between each trip. Golf carts can accommodate drop-off at assigned seats for guests with mobility issues.

OBT has a dedicated health and safety committee and a Covid-19 manager working to ensure best practices. The guidelines listed here will be modified as the situation evolves. We will be emailing specific instructions to guests before the performance.

\* The Jordan Schnitzer CARE Summerstage is a tented temporary performance venue located between OMSI and Portland Opera. The audience will be seated in socially distant pods in a tented structure with flooring. We recommend wearing weather-appropriate attire and flat shoes to the performance, as there is gravel between the parking lot and the seating area. A restroom trailer is on-site for your convenience.
